The successful applicant will be responsible for not only conducting researches but strengthening capabilities of the large-energy and high-power laser facilities called GEKKO-XII and LFEX, which are 100 percent open to researchers in the world as Joint Usage/Research facility, and also teaching classes at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
