

Faculty Position in the Institute of Laser Engineering, Osaka University

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Outline	Osaka University invites applications for a full-time faculty position at the rank of Professor in the Matrix Co-Creation Promotion Center (MCCPC), which was established in the Institute of Laser Engineering (ILE) on June 1st, 2022 and valid through March 31st, 2027. MCCPC aims to realize a virtuous circle of human resources and knowledge through strategical and synergistical development of interdisciplinary collaboration, international collaboration, industry-university collaboration, and facility collaboration based on high-power-lasers, in cooperation with multiple departments of the University. Particularly, the Center is envisioning collaborative research with the humanities, including archaeology, cultural heritage science, and material culture studies. The successful applicants will contribute to the research programs in collaborations with institutions in ASEAN countries and other countries, and will also supervise students at Graduate School of Humanities in Osaka University.
