

Faculty Position in the Institute of Laser Engineering, the University of Osaka

Outline	The Quadruple Matrix Center (QMC) of the Institute of Laser Engineering (ILE), at the University of Osaka, aims to foster a virtuous cycle of human resources and knowledge by strategically and organically developing interdisciplinary collaboration, international collaboration, industry-university collaboration, and facility collaboration based on high-power lasers, in cooperation with multiple departments within the University. This Center was established on June 1, 2022, and will be a time-limited organization until March 31, 2027. The Center's goal of interdisciplinary collaboration is not limited to laser science and materials science, but also includes development/applied anthropology, archaeology, and heritage science. As part of its activities, the University of Osaka invites applications for a full-time faculty position at the rank of Professor. The successful candidate will also be involved in teaching graduate and undergraduate students at the Graduate School of Humanities at the University of Osaka.

Responsibilities	 (1) Promote Southeast Asian development/applied anthropology, archaeology, and heritage science with a focus on energy issues through the application of laser technology, in cooperation with the University's Graduate Schools of Economics, and the Graduate School of Humanities, and other departments. (2) Develop interdisciplinary research that fuses the humanities and sciences at ILE. (3) Promote collaboration with educational and research institutions in the Southeast Asian region to develop integrated humanities-science education and research. (4) Provide research guidance on Southeast Asian development/applied anthropology, archaeology, and heritage science to master's and doctoral students, as well as undergraduate students.
7. Qualifications	[Essential] Applicants must have: (1) A Ph.D. or equivalent in related field. (2) Current employment at a university or higher education research institution in an ASEAN member country, with sufficient experience in promoting international academic research and exchange with ASEAN member countries. (3) English language proficiency sufficient to fulfill one's work duties. [Preferred] (1) A position equivalent to that of a professor (full-time) at the current institution. (2) Academic research experience in East Asian & Southeast Asian environmental history, in connection with the University of Osaka's ASEAN Campus.

9. Term of Employment	The contract period is 6 months from the date of employment. The contract will not be renewed after the expiration of the contract period. *The maximum cumulative contract term is based on "Regulations Pertaining to Contract Period of National University Corporation Osaka University Fixed-term Staff, etc."
