

Faculty Position in the Institute of Laser Engineering, the University of Osaka

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Outline	The Center for Matrix Co-Creation Promotion attached to the Institute for Laser Science at the University of Osaka aims to realize a virtuous circle of human resources and knowledge by strategically and organically developing interdisciplinary, international, industry-university, and facility collaborations centered on power lasers, in cooperation with several departments of the university. In addition, the Institute aims to contribute to the development of the community as a Joint Usage / Research Center for "High Energy Density Science," to create new science by utilizing high-power lasers, and to become an international research center for high energy density science and laser fusion science.
